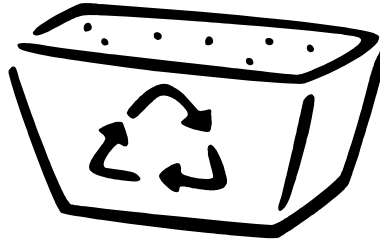


VILLAGE OF TOBACCOVILLE

RECYCLING GUIDELINES



The Village of Tobacconville and Kiser Garbage would like to thank you for recycling. Please place your recycling container(s) no more than eight feet from the curb by 7:00 a.m. on pick-up day, which is every other Monday. Please follow the recycling instructions carefully, and if you should have any questions about your garbage or recycling service, please direct all calls to Village Hall at 983-0029. Residents are issued up to two 18-gallon recycling bins at no charge. Or residents may use any suitable receptacle constructed of plastic, metal, or fiberglass having adequate handles for lifting, subject to Village approval.

ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS	PREPARATION	UNACCEPTABLE
Newspapers & inserts and magazines.	Keep dry and stack together inside a bag. If raining, please cover.	No junk mail, no scrap office paper & no phone books.
Glass	Remove lids, rinse clean, & remove label if possible.	No dishes, no glasses, no light bulbs, no window glass, no mirrors, & no broken bottles.
Aluminum & steel cans	Rinse clean & remove label if possible. Please rinse out cat & dog food cans.	No aerosol cans, no paint cans, & no baking pans.
Plastic containers are required to be labeled as provided below; must have a neck smaller than the body of the container and accept a screw top, snap cap, or other closure. PETE #1, HDPE #2, V3, LDPE4, PP5, PS6, and OTHER 7.	Look on bottom for recyclable symbol. Remove lid & neck ring if possible. Rinse clean & remove label if possible. Crush & please do not cut into pieces.	No containers used for oil, brake fluid, pesticide, anti-freeze; no margarine tubs, yogurt tubs, medicine bottles, & no plastic bags.
Thin cardboard boxes such cereal boxes & canned drink boxes.	Crush flat and assemble with newspapers & magazines. Please do not cut into pieces.	No pizza boxes, no gift boxes, & no corrugated cardboard.
