CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Keith Snow called the meeting to order. Rev. Bryant Madren gave the invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Council Member Shore-Smith made a motion to approve the March 4, 2010 Council Meeting Minutes and March 4, 2010 Budget Workshop Meeting Minutes. Mayor Pro Tem Marion seconded. The vote was unanimous.
