

**VILLAGE OF TOBACCOVILLE  
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
Thursday, April 7, 2011 - 7 p.m.**

**CALL TO ORDER**

Mayor Keith Snow called the meeting to order and gave the invocation. The following elected officials and staff were present: Mayor Keith Snow, Mayor Pro Tem Myron Marion, Council Members Mark Baker, Robin Beck, and Lori Shore-Smith, Attorney Amy Lanning, and Administrator Dan Corder. No one represented the press. Total attendance: 14.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Mayor Pro Tem Marion made a motion to approve the March 3, 2011 Budget Workshop Meeting Minutes and Council Meeting Minutes as presented. Council Member Shore-Smith seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous.

**PRESENTATION OF WESTERN RURAL AREA DEVELOPMENT ASSESSMENT**

Mr. Paul Norby, Planning Director and Mr. Glenn Simmons, Planner with the City County Planning Department, presented a slide presentation to the Council regarding the Western Rural Area Development Assessment. Mr. Norby and Mr. Simmons answered questions from the Council afterwards.

**FINANCIAL REPORT**

Administrator Corder reviewed the February financial report. Mayor Pro Tem Marion conducted an internal audit of the records and found no discrepancies. (Attachments)

**DAY OF PRAYER PROCLAMATION**

Council Member Beck made a motion to declare May 5, 2011 as a *Day of Prayer* in the Village of Tobacoville. Council Member Shore-Smith seconded the motion. There will be a noon observance for the community at the gazebo in the Village Park. (Attachment)

**UPDATE ON PROHIBITING SEX OFFENDERS FROM THE VILLAGE PARK**

After receiving an update from Attorney Lanning, the Council directed her to proceed with creating a rough draft ordinance which prohibits sex offenders from the Village Park. There was a consensus of the Council to revisit this item at the May meeting.. Council Member Baker requested a speaker from the Forsyth County Sheriff's Department address the Council with relevant information at the May meeting.

**RESOLUTION #147 IN SUPPORT OF FORSYTH COUNTY ORDINANCE REGARDING DOG TETHERING**

Several Council members said they had been contacted by citizens regarding the issue of dog tethering. After further discussion, there was a consensus of the Council to table this issue until the May Council meeting in order to allow additional citizen comments.

**SET BUDGET WORKSHOP DATE**

Administrator Corder advised the Council that he will present the preliminary Budget for Fiscal 2011-2012 at the May Council meeting. There was a consensus that scheduling a budget workshop was unnecessary.

**ADJOURNMENT**

Mayor Pro Tem Marion made a motion to adjourn. Council Member Beck seconded the motion and the meeting adjourned at 8:40 p.m.
