

**VILLAGE OF TOBACCOVILLE
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES**

Thursday, July 7, 2011 - 7 p.m.

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Keith Snow called the meeting to order and gave the invocation. The following elected officials and staff were present: Mayor Keith Snow, Mayor Pro Tem Myron Marion, Council Members Mark Baker, Robin Beck, and Lori Shore-Smith, Attorney Amy Lanning, Administrator Dan Corder and Clerk Robin Key. No one represented the press. Total attendance: 9

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Council Member Shore-Smith made a motion to approve the June 2, 2011 Council Meeting Minutes. Council Member Beck seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous.

ADMINISTRATOR'S UPDATE & STATUS SHEET REVIEW

Administrator Corder addressed the Council with project updates. (Attachment)

PARC UPDATE

Chairman Becky Moore-Dodson updated the Council on plans for the 20th Anniversary Celebration scheduled for Saturday, September 10, 2011. (Attachment) There was a consensus of the Council to purchase 400 tote bags and 300 Frisbees as souvenir gifts for attendees at the Celebration. Council Member Beck made a motion to appoint Reba Moore Dollyhite to a 2-year term to the PARC 2011-2013. Council Member Shore-Smith seconded the motion. Mrs. Dodson advised the Council that Cyndi Bramblett-Ashbaugh resigned from the PARC.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Administrator Corder reviewed the May financial report. Mayor Pro Tem Marion conducted an internal audit of the records and found a minor discrepancy to be resolved when the June statements are reconciled. (Attachments)

PARK SIGNAGE – ORDINANCE #134

In order to prohibit registered sex offenders from entering the Village Park and recreational facilities, the Council passed Ordinance #134 at the June Council Meeting. Regarding park signage, there was a consensus of the Council to order four (4) blue signs with white letters, using a combination of the wording from the sample signs shown in the supporting *attached documents*.

Mayor Keith Snow left the meeting, and Mayor Pro Tem Myron Marion presided from this point forward.

INTERPRETATION OF NUISANCE ORDINANCE #44

The Council discussed clarification of the term *acreage* for enforcement of Ordinance #44 *An Ordinance Providing for the Prevention and Abatement of Public Nuisances Caused by the*

Uncontrolled Growth of Noxious Weeds and Grass and the Accumulation of Refuse. There was a consensus of the Council that *acreage* refers to 1 acre lots or more.

Council Member Beck made a motion to adjourn. Council Member Baker seconded the motion and the meeting adjourned at 8:00 p.m.
