

**Minutes**  
**Park and Recreation Committee**  
**April 12, 2011**

**Call to Order:** Chairman Becky Moore Dodson called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m.

**Approval of Minutes:** After a correction to the minutes to remove information regarding Wanda Benbow agreeing to help Lee Ault with Tobacco barn cleaning, a motion was made to approve the minutes for the March 8, 2011 meeting by Lonnie Ring and seconded by Lee Ault. The minutes were approved.

**Administrator's Update:** Village Administrator Dan Corder updated the PARC committee. The finished budget will be submitted in May and once again this year, there will not be a tax increase. It will be a tight budget but there is a possibility the PARC could see a couple of thousand additional dollars added into the PARC budget. Bulk pick-up is completed and for the first time in 10 years, it was finished within 1½ days. Council Representative Shore-Smith added that the Council is considering prohibiting sex offenders from using the Park.

Anniversary Celebration: Saturday, September 10, 2011, 11 a.m.-2 p.m. - 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary!  
An anniversary gift giveaway was discussed. Items talked about were water bottle huggies, calendars, key chains. Dan and Lori will check further into prices. Jack Strayhorn and the Distant Thunder Band has agreed to perform. Lonnie Ring made a motion that we book this band and pay them \$500 for the performance. Motion was seconded by Wanda Benbow. Food will consist of hotdogs, beans, chips and tea. A total of 1,200 hotdogs, 600 chips and 600 beans portions were prepared last year. The cost was \$2,693.75 and Bill Benbow confirmed that Rainbow Catering will cater the event for the same price as last year. Previous Mayors will be recognized, and a program will be copied for the event.
