

**Minutes**  
**Park and Recreation Committee**  
**March 8, 2011**

**Call to Order:** Chairman Becky Moore Dodson called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m.

**Administrator’s Update:** Village Administrator Dan Corder brought the Committee up to date on the turn lane project at Doral Dr./Spainhour Mill Rd. The Right of Way was purchased by the Village and dedicated to the D.O.T. to proceed with correcting the turn lane.

**Council Representative’s Update:** Lori Shore-Smith informed the committee that a D.O.T. employee attended the Council meeting to let them know that a Bike Lane Study can be done in Tobaccoville. Also, road signs must be reflective by 2018. There are approximately 200 signs in the Village that will be replaced over the next few years.

Captain Jim and the Petting Zoo are booked for the event and Dan will check with the face painter. Food will consist of Hotdogs, Beans, Chips and Tea. A total of 1200 hotdogs, 600 chips and 600 beans were prepared last year. The cost was \$2693.75 and Bill Benbow and Becky Moore Dodson will check in to food prices for this year. Wanda Benbow made a motion
